

# Routes in town suitable for wheelchair users

## ROUTE FROM THE HAUPTPLATZ/HERRENGASSE (APPROX. 2.5 KM)

**Accessibility:** all tram lines at “Hauptplatz”, disabled parking spaces on Landhausgasse/Raubergasse, Kaiserfeldgasse/Schmiedgasse (in the vicinity of the Amtshaus) and short-stay parking zone. Most of the streets referred to below are suitable for wheelchairs (flat paving stones/asphalt), if not this is indicated accordingly.

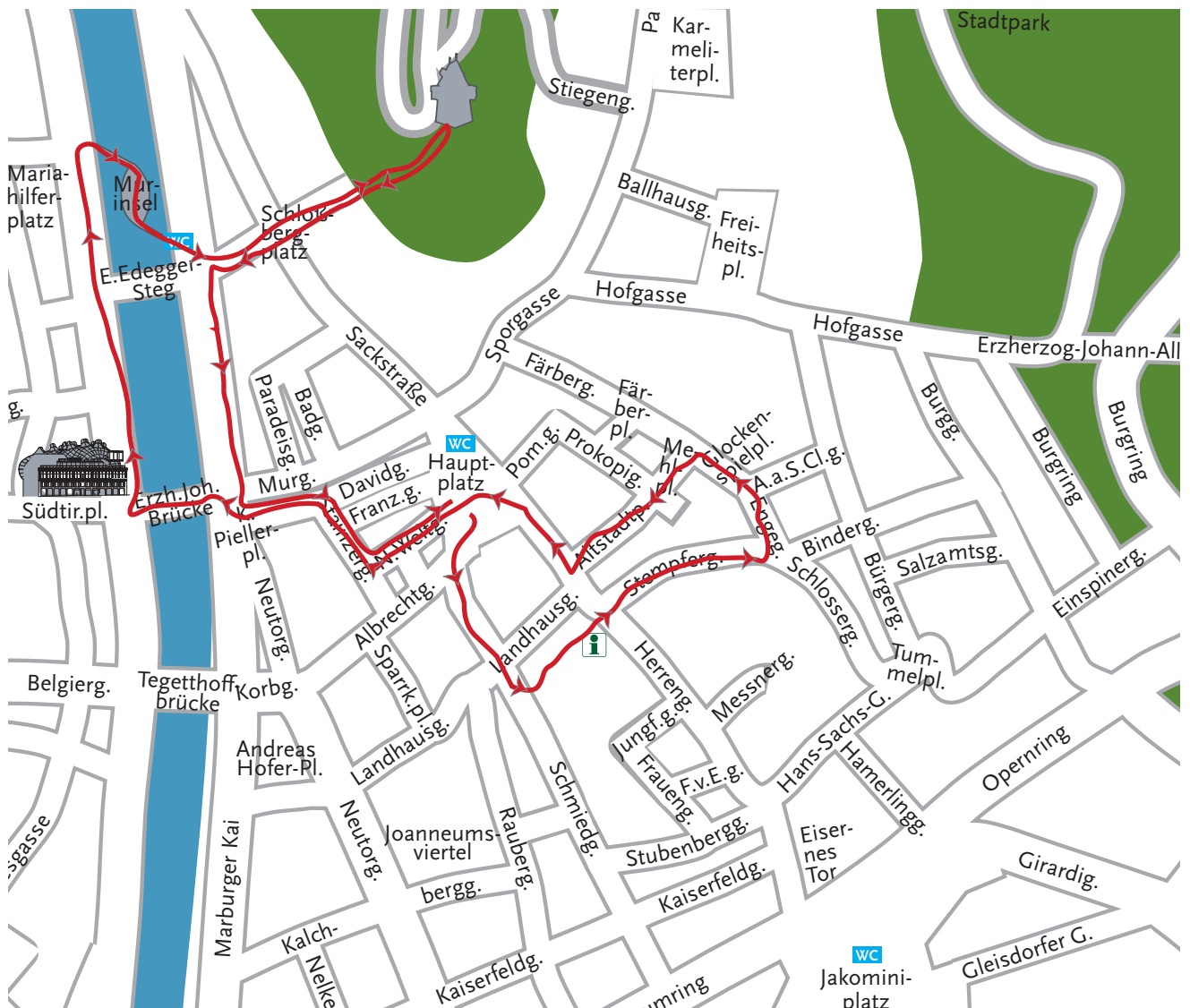
**Route:**

Hauptplatz (**Town Hall**) – Schmiedgasse – **Landhaushof** (some paving stones) – Stempfergasse – Engegasse – Glockenspielplatz (**Glockenspiel**; some paving stones)\* – Mehlplatz – Altstadtpassage – Herrengasse –

Hauptplatz – Neue-Welt-Gasse – Stainzergasse (**Franziskanerviertel**; paving stones) – Erzherzog-Johann-bridge (view of **Art Museum, Mur Island, Schlossberg**) – Lendkai to **Mur Island** (easy to cross: ramp at Lendkai, lift at Kaiser-Franz-Josef-Kai) –

Schlossbergplatz – with the **Schlossberg lift** to the Schlossberg (views over Graz and **clock tower** – path directly to the clock tower: short section along an asphalt road, downhill, very steep) – return to starting point with the Schlossberg lift – Kaiser-Franz-Josef-Kai – Stainzergasse – Neue-Welt-Gasse – Hauptplatz.

## EXTENSION FOR THOSE INTERESTED, SPORTS AND ENDURANCE ENTHUSIASTS (+ 2 KM)

### Accessibility:

A detour leads to the “Stadtkrone”, with the cathedral, mausoleum and Graz Castle, as the direct path via the Bürgergasse, Burggasse or also over the Sporgasse is very steep and arduous.

This route can also be planned as a separate tour and/or Stadtkrone can be reached publicly (up to the “Schauspielhaus”, from there it is approx. 100 m to the Stadtkrone). By car: designated disabled parking spaces are available around the Freiheitsplatz/Schauspielhaus.

### Route – starting at Herrengasse:

Hans-Sachs-Gasse – Tummelplatz – Einspinnergasse (uphill!) – left into the Burgring (uphill!) – left into Erzherzog-Johann-Allee – through the **Burgtor** (cobblestones): pleasant views to the left of the **Opera House** (end of Burggasse); right into the courtyard of **Graz Castle** (pleasant view of the whole of the cathedral and view of entrance portal/lowest steps of **double spiral staircase** – unfortunately not accessible) – leave the courtyard for the **cathedral** opposite (cobblestones all around; entrance with flat stone ramp; automatic door opener on right before the information board; ca. 3 cm door stop) – leave the cathedral and head left towards the **Mausoleum** (unfortunately not accessible) – along Hofgasse on the left (**Schauspielhaus, Alte Universität**) until Freiheitsplatz – possibly until the elaborate wooden doorway of Edegger-Tax royal bakery – same route back.
