Since 2003, there has also been a *Café Sacher* in Graz adjacent to the Town Hall. This traditional café-restaurant draws its inspiration from the *Café Sacher* in Vienna. The daily menu offers all that the heart desires, from tempting breakfast options to Viennese pastries, through to the classics of Sacher cuisine, such as the “Viennese Platter”, Eduard Sacher’s Tafelspitz (boiled beef), and “Anna Sacher” fried chicken. Parking

- Disabled parking spaces in Landhausgasse, Raubergasse and the short-stay parking zone there

ENTRANCE AREA

- 2 separate cafés
 - Smoking café which only has high tables and bar stools, accessible via third door
 - Non-smoking café (restaurant) at the very back (end of the corridor; take care: ends of carpeting not fixed in place)
- Otherwise step-free
- Hinged door; bar handle on outside, lever handle on inside
- Clear door width 2 x 75 cm

INTERIOR AREA

- Tables and chairs movable (some benches are fixed in place)
- Table height 75 cm
- Tables with centre table leg
- Wooden floor, partially carpeted (entrance area)

ACCESSIBLE TOILET

- WCs in front of the entrance to the non-smoking area on the left (only for patrons of the café)
- Door to the toilets is a hinged door; bar handle on outside, electric door opener on inside
- Clear door width 90 cm
- WC door is hinged door with lever handle
- Clear door width 90 cm
- 190 x 165 cm
- WC height 52.5 cm
- WC accessible from the right, 95 cm space
- 2 handrails, each with a height of 80 cm
- Handrail on the right folds upwards
- Washbasin 85 cm high, very small, in corner, no under-washbasin wheelchair access
- Tilting mirror

- Guide dogs allowed
- Baby changing table in the disabled WC
- No separate breastfeeding area, but possible at any time
- Staff happy to read menu to blind people
